### IMPORTANT CIRCULAR

To,

Dean/Director/Principal/Teachers of  
All Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha Colleges

**Subject: - Migration of Teaching staff in the academic session 2017-18**

Sir/Madam,

Whereas, it has been observed that a number of teachers have been found resigning from the existing ASU colleges after attending the inspections conducted by this council for the academic year 2017-18 and also from the colleges obtained permission for a period not exceeding 5 years and joining the other ASU Colleges in the same academic session.

It is also found that, some teachers are migrating from one college to another college frequently especially during the period of visitation for the reasons best known for them.

Whereas, this is to remind to all ASU Colleges that, this council vide its letter dated 09.01.2017 issued "**guidelines to Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani colleges are issued in order to streamline the transfer of teaching faculty from one Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani College to another and also to avoid duplicity (same teacher(s) in more than one college in same academic session):-**

**1. Each faculty on the day of inspection of particular academic session will be considered as staff for that academic session for the same Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani Colleges only.**

**2. Faculty shall not be considered the member of teaching staff of any college if he/she has been shown in the faculty list of more than one Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani Colleges during the inspection in the same academic year."**

Whereas, this is to remind to all such migrating teachers as at the time of inspection they had submitted a declaration on notarized affidavit stating that, they will remain in that college till the completion of the academic year and those teachers will not be considered in any other college during the same academic year.

Therefore the teachers migrating from one college to another college would be counted at only one college for the said academic year wherever she / he appeared first, as the recommendations for permission given by Council is based on the faculty present at that college and hence shall not be considered in the second college as they had already present in first college visited and submitted the declaration.

Example: Teachers present at the time of inspection in the existing college shall not be considered for the said academic years if they are present in the inspection of colleges for issue of LOP.

It is observed that, such frequent migration of teachers leads to hindrance to achieve the aim of quality education in ASU colleges, therefore it is reiterated that, all the teachers of the ASU colleges under the purview of this council will be considered eligible in only one college for single academic session.

All the concerned i.e. college authorities / teachers are hereby informed that, being a part of the CCIM's Mission to achieve the best quality in Indian Medicine Education System in the country, it is expected that, everyone concerned will act responsibly to attain the quality education in Indian medicine and it is the duty of the college to maintain the infrastructural and other standards as per the MSR throughout the year.

It is once again emphasized that, the CCIM has adopted online visitation and online teacher migration system through which all the colleges / teachers are monitored throughout the year.
