Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to say that it has been decided that it would be mandatory to fulfil 100% requirements of MSR Regulations of concerned systems for Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani (ASU) college to run or start Post-graduate courses. In addition, the ASU colleges shall submit following information whenever they apply for Post-graduate courses:

- i. Performance of passing percentage of Under-graduate students of last three years (Batches).
- ii. Whether the attached hospital of the college is NABH accredited or not?

2. Further, the Central Council of Indian Medicine is hereby also requested to communicate this policy decision to all concerned colleges, Universities and State Governments and also to place the same on the Council’s website for wider publicity.
