NOTICE

Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi, a Statutory Body under the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi, invites sealed tenders with profile from reputed and experienced Legal Agencies to look after legal work of the office of CCIM and to watch /defend the court cases in the High Courts and Supreme Court of India on behalf of the Central Council of Indian Medicine keeping in view of the following guidelines. The interested Legal Agencies/Firm are requested drop to their tender alongwith financial bid separately in sealed cover and in the tender box at the office of CCIM on or before 24.03.2017 upto 4.00 P.M. No tenders will be accepted after the stipulated time.

GUIDELINES

1. Agency will inform its panel of counsels to CCIM, if any available, in all the High Courts of each States.
2. Senior Advocate, if required, will be engaged by the Agency with the written approval of the Competent Authority of CCIM only.
3. Fee (In case of Senior Advocate) will be fixed by agency only after getting the prior sanction of the Competent Authority of CCIM.
4. Agency engaged by CCIM shall submit report of each case monthly.
5. Payment shall be restricted as per Govt. rates (Ministry of Law) as amended time to time.
6. CCIM is empowered to engage any Advocate, at any time without any notice to the Agency and will consider the issue of fee of Advocates keeping in view of the merit of case.
7. The claim for payment will be considered with original bills & supporting documents only.
8. The Advocate for defending the case in High Courts and Supreme Court of India will be identified by the Agency.
9. The CCIM reserves the right to cancel/terminate the contract with the agency at any time without assigning any reason.
