

Guidelines for the issuance of Teachers' Code Number by the Central Council of Indian Medicine

- Teachers Code Number is a unique Alpha Numeric Code issued only to the Eligible Teachers of Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha colleges by the CCIM.
- Only Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha colleges can apply online for the Teachers' Code Number for their Eligible Teachers via Institution Login and apply for the Teachers' Code on line.
- Code numbers are allotted to the Eligible Teachers only on the basis of Eligibility Criteria set by the CCIM as prescribed in the respective Notified Regulations and Policy decisions taken by the Council.
- Colleges while applying for Teachers' Code must upload self attested copies of the following documents in respect of the newly appointed teachers such as
 - (i) Duly Filled Faculty Data Base Form of the teacher verified by the Principal of the College.
 - (ii) UG/PG Degree Certificate
 - (iii) State/Central Registration Certificate
 - (iv) Appointment letter
 - (v) Joining letter
 - (vi) Notarized Affidavit in respect of the appointed teacher
 - (vii) Forwarding letter from the Principal
 - (viii) Order in respect of the shifting to the allied Department.
 - (ix) Undertaking from the Teacher not to shift to the previous department in future once the Code is issued by CCIM.
- In case of teachers who wish to join some other college, the NOC from the previous College and Resignation/Experience certificate also required.
- After uploading the said documents by the Colleges, same will be verified by the concerned section of CCIM.
- After verification of the documents from the available records the Teachers' Code will be issued.
- The Teachers Code is not transferrable.
